For example "lowrider" had a 255:1 ratio in hip hop vs. other genres, but was only used 116 times in 26 million words. TF-IDF: to determine the words that characterize each hip-hop artist, we used a technique called term frequency-inverse document frequency (tf-idf). Each rapper gets assigned a tf-idf score for every word in the hip-hop corpus.
