To make a rag quilt, start by cutting some old cotton or denim fabric into 7- by 7-inch squares. Then, stitch the squares together, wrong-side up, working on 1 row at a time. Once you've finished all of the rows, sew them together, and sew 1 inch inside the outer border all around the quilt.
