Untreated, an aortic dissection can lead to death. A dissection that involves the ascending aorta almost always requires emergency open-heart surgery to repair the vessel and prevent death. Surgical Treatment of Aortic Dissection Treatment for aortic dissection is usually an emergency surgery. The procedure involves replacing the damaged portion of the aorta with a synthetic tube graft (polyester tube). If the base of the aorta (aortic root) and the aortic valve are involved, these areas may also need repair or replacement.
