This is due to a air to fuel ratio imbalance, either the fuel system is delivering too much fuel into the engine or there is not enough clean air (oxygen) a few things to look for :

- Faulty injectors (injectors need attention at about 100.000 to 120 000 miles)
- Faulty injector pump.
- Dirty air cleaner.

Dirty carburetor - A dirty or clogged carburetor will cause the engine to not receive the fuel air mixture properly. Secondly, a bad or weak mix of air and fuel will not ignite properly. Clean the carburetor either while on the engine, or remove and then clean the unit.
